



Register for our Online Listening Session

On Saturday May 25th 2024, Archbishop Mark will be holding an Online Open Listening Session. Anyone from the Archdiocese of Cardiff and the Diocese of Menevia is welcome to attend.

Format

As with the 'in person' Open Listening Sessions, the session starts with an introduction by Archbishop Mark on why we are considering a union of both the Dioceses of Cardiff and Menevia, some of the challenges and benefits, and a brief history of both Dioceses. People will then go into groups ('breakout rooms on Zoom) and be asked to consider 3 questions relating to the proposed union of the two Dioceses.

A spokesperson for each group will come back with the findings after each question and we will conclude with a Q&A session with Archbishop Mark. A summary of the findings from this session (like all other sessions) will be typed up and these, in turn, will be forwarded to the Vatican. Please note that the final decision on whether to unite will be taken by the Holy Father following this open listening and consultative phase.
